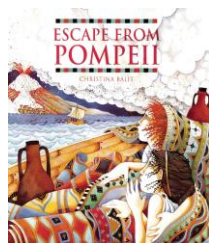
Information for Spring 1 2023

Here are some of the topics we will be covering during Spring 1..

English

Our writing will be based around the Escape from Pompeii by Christina Balit which links to our history topic about the Romans. This is an adventure story about the destruction of Pompeii following the eruption of Mount Vesuvius.

During our reading sessions the children are exposed to a variety of text types, a wide range of vocabulary and are taught a range of skills to help their reading and understanding.



Maths

We will be focussing on addition and subtraction this half term and building on the skills that the children learnt in previous years. The children in Year 4 will take a Multiplication Tables Check in Summer 2023 and have already been working hard practising their times tables on TTRockstars and on timestables.co.uk. Lots of the children are already quite confident in many of the times tables.

Science

This term we are learning about rocks. We will be comparing rocks and learning how fossils are formed.



RE

The topic this half term is Judaism during which the children will be learning about synagogues and important Jewish festivals.

History

Our history topic this half term is all about the Romans. The children will learn about the Roman invasion of Britain, a comparison of modern and ancient Roman life and the events at Pompeii,.

Art

Our art topic is formal elements of art in which the children will learn about the simple shapes of objects and how they can use these to sketch and add more detail..

Geography

Extreme Earth is the geography focus for this term and the children will be learning about volcanoes and earthquakes.

DT

Creating an electrical poster.

French

We are learning about clothes and colours.
