Information for Autumn 2023

Welcome to the first of our newsletters. This year all the classes have new names and in year 3 we are The Stuarts, named after one of the important historical periods in British history.

English

Our writing will be based around the Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura which links to our history topic about the Stone Age. This is an adventure story about a boy who travels back in time to the Stone Age.

STONE AGE

BOY

During our reading sessions the children are exposed to a variety of text types, a wide range of socabulary and are taught a range of skills to help their reading and understanding.

Maths

We will be focussing on place value, addition and suit and multiplication and division this term and buildileng on the skills that the children learnt in previous years. We will be using concrete and practical resources to support understanding before moving on to pictorial and abstract questions. The children will have opportunities to apply the skills they have learnt to solve problems and give reasons for their answers. Additionally, we will be focusing an arithmetic skills to enhance the childrens' skills.

Science

Animals including humans and racks will form the basis of learning in science until Christmas. The children will learn about nutrition, skeletons, different racks and how fassils are formed.

RE

In this term our theme will be "What is the Bible and why is it important to Christians?".

History

Our first history topic will be The Stone Age. We will be learning about how we have been able to find out about life in the Stone Age from the clues they have left such as Skara Brae and Stonehenge and what it was like to be alive in this period.

Our art tapic links to history so we will be creating art in the style of the Stane Age such as case art using natural materials.

Geography

This term we will be exploring our local area and examining different land uses.

<u>DT</u>

We will be exploring seasonal foods.

French

This term the children will be learning nacabulary to talk about themselves and introduce themselves to athers.
