### English:

This term Edwardians will be writing all about traditional tales.



### Mathematics

For this half-term, children will be learning all about number and place value within 10; addition and subtraction within 10; shape.



### Reading

This term, children will continue to use Little Wandle to support their reading skills. We will have two sessions of phonics per day in order to help them to catch up. The sessions are followed up with reading sessions which will happen three times a week. Then the book that your child has been reading, will be sent home for your child to read to you.



### Homework

Children will be sent home with work to complete this will be based on phonics, writing and maths. Homework must be completed and returned every Wednesday.

Please ensure your child is reading at least 3 times per week at home. Reading books need to be brought into school on Tuesday and Friday.
