Here is a list of subject areas your child will be learning during Spring 1.

English:

Our book this term is *The Tiger Who Came to Tea*. We will be focusing on reading with expression, sequencing the events of the story, writing a retelling and innovation. The children will also write a fact file about tigers.

Mathematics

For this half-term, children will be consolidating fundamentals of mathematics, and deepen their learning in the following areas: place value, addition, subtraction and shape.

Reading

This term, some children will continue to use *Little Wandle* to support their reading skills. These children will have two sessions of phonics per day in order to help them to catch up. The sessions are followed up with reading sessions which will happen three times a week and then the book that your child has been reading will be sent home for you to share.

Along side this, children will be developing their reading and comprehension skills in their English lessons.

Homework

Spellings will be sent home weekly and tested on Fridays. Homework will also be sent out weekly and needs to be returned on Fridays.

Please ensure your child is reading at least 3 times per week at home. Reading books need to be brought into school every day.
