Primary PE and Sport Premium 2023-2024 Report

The below table displays the Primary PE and Sport Premium spend for All Saints National Academy during the 2023-2024 academic year. During the final term of the academic year of 2023-2024 the Senior Leadership Team and PE Leads within the academy will combine = an analysis to identify the future needs in order to improve the quality of PE and school sport in a sustainable way, using the government funding.

The total amount of funding given to the academy during the 2023-2024 academic year is £16000 plus £10 per pupil (total: £18,240). The government have given all schools the following areas to consider:

- the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
- the profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- increased participation in competitive sport
