Please ensure that all clothes, bags, bottles and lunchboxes are clearly labelled with your child's name. It is your child's responsibility to care for their own belongings.




Star Learner

Reading

This term, the children will continue to use Little Wandle Phonics to support their reading skills. Please ensure your child is reading at least 3 times per week at home and that books are returned to school every day.

Writing the children will be continuing to write their names- both Christian name and surname. Writing activities will be related to each book- such as Wanted Posters for the Big Bad Wolf and letters to Goldilocks.

Mathematics

During this half term we will continue counting beyond 10 and recognising numerals. We will begin to add numbers together within 10. Some of the children are taking an interest in time so we will look at O Clock and half past. We will also use the language of size and weight- bigger than, smaller than, heaviest, lightest etc.

RE

There will be a visit to All Saints Church.

We will be thinking about people who are special to us.

During the week beginning 23rd January we will be celebrating Chinese New Year.



The Wider Early Years Curriculum

Our topic this half term is 'Once Upon A Time'. We will be looking at traditional Stories. Each week we will focus on one story but will read others along the way. Our main stories are
Goldilocks and the 3 Bears
Little Red Riding Hood
Jack & The Beanstalk
The 3 Little Pigs
3 Billy Goats Gruff

We will be using a variety of media to make pictures and models. For example, will make stick puppets and masks to retell stories. We look at simple routes which are important to us- such as our way to school. We will also use the Beebots to follow routes, like Red Riding Hood going through the woods.

Our role play area will reflect the different stories that we are learning about. For example, we will have a 3 Bear's Cottage.
